The role: Logistics Manager

To lead and manage the brewery's logistics operations and distribution site ensuring the safe, efficient, and compliant distribution of products. The role is responsible for order capture, warehouse inventory, fleet operations, driver performance and delivering high service standards to customers while maintaining legal and regulatory compliance.

Key responsibilities:

- Manage end-to-end transport operations from the brewery site, through our distribution centre, into both customer depots and directly to pubs by utilising our own primary and dray fleet.
- Lead, manage, and develop a team of primary drivers, draymen, warehouse and office team promoting safe working practices and high performance.
- Inventory management to ensure stock accuracy, rotation and full traceability. Work closely with the brewery and warehouse teams to ensure stock availability and accurate loading.
- Ensure safe manual handling of casks and kegs, embedding a strong health & safety culture.
- Maintain compliance with transport legislation, including driver hours, tachographs, and vehicle safety.
- Plan and optimise multi-drop delivery routes, considering access restrictions and delivery conditions.
- Manage fleet operations, including vehicle availability, maintenance, and cleanliness.
- Monitor and control transport costs, including fuel usage, vehicle utilization and vehicle repairs and maintenance.
- Investigating incidents, accidents, and customer complaints, implementing corrective actions.
- Ensure high standards of customer service are consistently delivered by the dray team.
- Drive continuous improvement across dray operations, including efficiency and safety initiatives.

- Understanding of cask and keg handling and cellar operations.
- Experience managing drays or similar heavy delivery operations.
- Health & Safety qualification (e.g. IOSH/NEBOSH).
- Have previous HGV driving experience.

The role involves manual handling and sitting / standing for extended periods. Applicants must be able to meet the physical demands of the role, with reasonable adjustments provided where required.
